Checklist for revising grammar and syntax:
☐ Be sure that you use grammar correctly. This includes subject-verb agreement, clear pronoun use, complete sentences, capitalization, etc.
☐ Check your spelling carefully; be sure to avoid commonly confused words.
☐ Check your punctuation carefully.
