

Checklist for revising grammar and syntax:

- Be sure that you use grammar correctly. This includes subject-verb agreement, clear pronoun use, complete sentences, capitalization, etc.
- Check your spelling carefully; be sure to avoid commonly confused words.
- Check your punctuation carefully.
